Information packet- Deadline to enter your name, June 21st

Hello! We are so happy you have decided to run for our Miss Roanoke Fall Festival Junior Queen. There are many opportunities that await you for the future! Our new Jr. Queen will reign over the Roanoke Fall Festival, ride in surrounding parades, and represent our community in other events. Here are some details about our Jr. Queen scholarship program. Please read this completely and be sure and ask questions.

1. The scholarship program will be held on Saturday, August 3rd at 2:00 p.m. in the Roanoke Elementary School in Roanoke, IN. The interview schedule will be determined by how many contestants we have. Most likely around noon.
2. The chosen Junior Queen will be a part of the court that will reign over the Fall Festival on Thursday evening, September 5th, Friday, September 6th, and Saturday, September 7th. Our Junior Queen must be able to attend all assigned events.
3. The deadline to enter will be on June 21, 2024, so we can prepare for the first practice. Please call or text the director with your intention to enter. Resumes, sponsorship money and pictures will be due on the first practice. We will have three opportunities for workshops for on stage speaking, interviews, modeling, and clothing choices in June/July. We strive to help everyone achieve their goals in this program. Please ask questions!
4. The entrant agrees to abide by the rules of the Roanoke Fall Festival Scholarship Program Committee now in effect or as announced hereafter.
5. The entrant will agree that the time, manner and method of judging shall be solely within the discretion of the RFF Scholarship Program Committee, and that the decision of the judges is final.
6. The RFF Scholarship Program Committee welcomes young ladies ages 12-15 to enter the program. You must be 12-15 years old on the day of the program.
7. Entrants can be from Huntington County or any surrounding county near Roanoke, IN. You will be representing the Roanoke Fall Festival.
8. An entrant must be of good moral character and shall not have been convicted of any crimes, have not been married, or is not pregnant.
9. An entrant is required to appear in three clothing changes during the competition:
 - ~Theme wear outfit (this can be your choice of theme, use your imagination, no swim attire please or masks that cover your face. Examples could be but not limited to sports outfit, going fishing with grampa, race car driver, going shopping, the festival theme of "Celebrate the 70's!" etc. Whatever shows off your personality). Please be sure clothing is clean, do not have rips or tears, and shoes are clean.
 - ~Interview outfit, such as a Sunday dress or dress pants, no jeans, no flip flops (to be worn for the interview only).
 - ~Party dress or long gown for the evening wear portion of the program.If you have any questions at all about your clothing choices, please ask the director!
10. Each entrant is required to have at least one (1) sponsor for \$25.00 due with your entry packet at the first practice. The contestant with the most sponsorship

money collected will be awarded the Top Sponsor as a court member and ride in the parade on Saturday of the festival. Please print exactly how your sponsor(s) want to be listed in our program and advertisement. Sponsorships can be any dollar amount. Make checks out to Roanoke Fall Festival.

11. Each entrant is required to provide 4 copies of their entry form or resume at the first practice. This form should be one page only. You can use the entry form provided or you may type out your own "resumé" listing your activities in a bullet list style. Please use white (no colored) paper or resume paper, with no pictures or clip art. Also, use the same format as listed with the same questions. Please include the first and last names of parents or legal guardians. If parent(s) live separately, please indicate how you would prefer them to be listed. Signatures are required for the contestant and a parent or legal guardian. The judges will see this form, so please type or print neatly. If you need help printing, don't hesitate to ask! We are happy to receive these via email and print on our end to help you out.
 12. Each entrant is required to submit a head and shoulders photograph of themselves for use in social media, or newspaper print, and our program. Emailing the photo to the director is encouraged, but not required.
 13. Judging will be based on the following points:
 - Interview – 40 points
 - Theme wear- 25 points
 - Evening Wear- 25 points
 - On stage question- 10 points(100 total points)
- The judge's decision will be final. No point sheets will be passed out by the committee, but you can ask the director for tips acquired by the judges if you wish to enter the program next year.
14. A \$100.00 Scholarship will be presented to the contestant chosen as Miss Roanoke Junior Queen. Checks will be written to the school of choice.
 15. The judges will choose a Junior Queen, runners-ups, (the number of runners-ups chosen will be according to how many entrants we have), Theme Wear winner, Interview winner, and Top Sponsor. The Junior Queen and the Top Sponsor will ride in the parade on Saturday.
 16. If chosen Junior Queen or a member of the court, the dress code for events is as follows: No ripped jeans or flip flops. No backless dresses or short skirts. No shirts with advertising (festival shirt is approved). We ask that you wear your crown and sash at all events. Thank you for putting your best foot forward!
 17. All entries (application forms, sponsorship money and list, and picture) must be in the hands of the scholarship program director by the first practice.

Checklist for entries due for the first practice on Monday, June 24th:

- _____ 4 copies of your one-page application (or) resumé. Type or print neatly.
- _____ Your sponsor form with at least a \$25 sponsor listed. (Please make sure you have the proper name of the businesses or individuals listed with how they would like their name to be advertised). Include all checks and money collected.
- _____ 4 x 6 photo of the contestant for the program and advertising. Your photo will be returned. This should be a head and shoulders shot only. Emailing the photo to the director is encouraged, but not required.

Summer Schedule: (VIP is Very Important Practice or event!)

Although we don't call our meetings "mandatory", it is in your best interest to attend all the practices and the Queen's Tea. Attendance will be taken. We worked hard to set a schedule early in the year so you can plan accordingly. We will keep practicing to one hour.

VIP! Friday, June 21st. Deadline to enter the Junior Queen Scholarship Program by midnight. You must text or email the director with your intention to run so we can prepare for the first practice. All we need on this day is your name.

Monday, June 24th. 1st practice at Seminary Church, Roanoke. 7 p.m. Resumes, sponsorship list and money, and pictures are due at this first practice. Dress is casual.

VIP! Sunday, July 14th- Queen's Tea. 1 p.m. at The Gathering Place, 547 Guilford Street in Huntington. This is a fun day to celebrate our royalty and get in an extra interview with guest judges. Food will be served. Sundress, dress, or dress slacks are required. We will have guests and take pictures!

Monday, July 22nd- 2nd practice at Seminary Church. 7 p.m. Dress is casual.

VIP! Monday, July 29th- final practice at Seminary Church. 7 p.m. This is your last practice before program day! Please attend. Casual dress but bring the shoes you will compete in for practice.

Saturday, August 3rd. Junior Queen Scholarship Program Day! Interview times will be determined by the number of contestants. They will be sometime after lunch. Program will start at 2 p.m. If you are chosen as the Junior Queen, you are required to return that evening for the Queen Scholarship Program for pictures. We would also love to see the rest of the court as well! Please wear your gowns. Re-entry tickets will be given out to family and friends to return that evening at no charge.
